The return and recycling program ensures that used products are recycled properly and processed to recover valuable plastics and metals to make new products. No HP print cartridges returned are sent to oceans or landfills.

Planet Partners Return and Recycling Program for HP Printing Supplies

HP uses a state-of-the-art recycling facility to process each return through a multi-phase recycling process.

- Cartridges are sorted, disassembled or shredded
- Separated into plastics and metals
- Residual ink, foam or toner is separated

Recovered plastic and metal are further processed into their raw forms so they can be used in new HP printers and print cartridges.

- Recycled plastic from empty cartridges is used to create new original HP cartridges.
- HP uses recycled materials extensively in packaging, paperboard, corrugated cardboard and recycled plastic.
- All HP cartridges and packaging are designed with sustainability in mind.

Making a Difference

Today more than 80% of original HP ink cartridges and 100% of HP toner cartridges are now manufactured with recycled content.



More than 4.7 billion recycled plastic bottles have been used by HP to manufacture new original HP Ink Cartridges.



More than 875 million Original HP ink and toner cartridges have been recycled by customers with HP Planet Partners.



More than 114 million Plastic hangers have been used by HP to manufacture new Original HP Ink and Toner Cartridges.
